- B.** *At dawn, O Lord, will us with your merciful love, and we shall exult and rejoice all our days.
Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us and upon the work of our hands. –Psalm 90: 14, 17*
- C.** *I will bless you day after day, O Lord, and praise your name forever and ever,
for you are kind to all and compassionate to all your creatures. –Psalm 145: 2, 9*
