ENTRANCE PROCESSION

The servers, priest, and bridal party enter the church during the entrance chant from the Psalms. The Roman Missal provides the following antiphon options (choose one):

- A.** *May the Lord send you help from the holy place and give you support from Zion. May he grant you your heart's desire and fulfill every one of your designs. –Psalm 20: 3, 5*
 - B.** *At dawn, O Lord, will us with your merciful love, and we shall exult and rejoice all our days. Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us and upon the work of our hands. –Psalm 90: 14, 17*
 - C.** *I will bless you day after day, O Lord, and praise your name forever and ever, for you are kind to all and compassionate to all your creatures. –Psalm 145: 2, 9*
