Jesus Christ chose to be born and grow up in the heart of the Holy Family of Joseph and Mary...

In our time, families are the primary centers of living, radiant faith—in world often alien and even hostile to faith. For this reason, the Second Vatican Council calls the family “*Ecclesia domestica* (the domestic Church).” Here in the bosom of the family, parents are ‘the first heralds of the faith to children. They should encourage them in the vocation which is proper to each child, fostering with special care any religious vocation.’ Here the father of the family, the mother, children, and all members of the family exercise *the priesthood of the baptized* in a privileged way “by the reception of the Sacraments, prayer and thanksgiving, the witness of a holy life, and self-denial and active charity.” Thus, the home is the first school of Christian life and “a school for human enrichment.” Here one learns endurance and the joy of work, fraternal love, generous — even repeated — forgiveness, and above all divine worship in prayer and the offering of one’s life.
