- 1. Opening prayer
- 2. Pastors report
 - a. Building update: Soil sampling is happening. There will be no formal ground breaking. Fence going up and work beginning soon.
 - b. Final cost will be just over 1.5 million. This figure includes everything we asked for, including the canopy over walkway between buildings.
 - c. Fr Will and staff picked saint names for all the classrooms.

 - *Revamped front office...Frassati Room (After a young Italian saint who inspired youth.
 - *New conference room...Pope St John Paul II

- 3. March for Life...
 - 11 people from the young adults went with Fr Will (schools and the government shut down from cold but 500,000 people came anyway.
- 4. Financial update
 - a. Just over 1.5 m building costs, but tithing has been up since Christmas.
 - b. "Jesus Shock" was well received. Some new families registered for RE after reading the book. Fr Will considering another gift in the future.
- 5. Staff Lenten practice.
 - a. The office staff will each give one hour per week from their work time to spend in prayer.
 - b. Council will decide at our next meeting a way to join in prayer, fasting or almsgiving as a community during lent.

 - * Discussion on how to build a parish culture for this.
 - *Possible ideas to explore in the near future: Ministry Fair (a lot of work) or monthly welcome after Mass (or night) for new parishioners
