And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod,

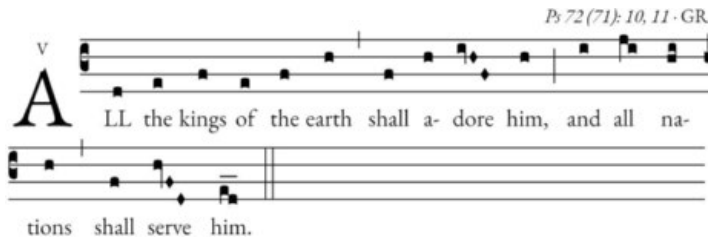
they departed for their country by another way.
