#### An update on the National Eucharist Pilgrimage:

As the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage continues to unfold, we are seeing Jesus in the Eucharist moving through towns and villages all across our nation!

This week the Marian Route continued through the Diocese of Winona-Rochester. Bishop Barron led a Eucharistic procession across the great Mississippi, accompanied by thousands, before passing the monstrance to Bishop Battersby of the Diocese of La Crosse in Wisconsin.

The St. Junipero Serra Route continued through the mountains as it moved from Utah into Colorado this week, making stops at several of the sites that Pope St. John Paul II visited when he was here for World Youth Day in 1993. More than 5,000 people participated in one of the Eucharistic processions that took place in Denver!


The St. Juan Diego Route journeyed through five dioceses in Louisiana, following the Gulf Coast, and is currently in Mississippi. The journey included a Eucharistic procession in the iconic French Quarter this week.

The St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Route visited the Basilica of the Assumption this week, America's first Cathedral. This route also journeyed to Washington, D.C., where a Mass was celebrated at the Basicilia of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception—our nation's largest Catholic church—followed by a Eucharistic procession and a visit to the St. John Paul II National Shrine. This route is now in Pennsylvania.








#### PENITENTIAL ACT



#### Profession of Faith
