Founded in Paris in 1833, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul is a worldwide community of more than 800,000 lay Catholics, known as Vincentians, who join together to grow spiritually by offering person-to-person service to neighbors in need by feeding, clothing, housing and healing individuals and families in our community who have nowhere else to turn for help.

Ideally it takes four officers (President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary) and a Spiritual Advisor to start a new conference. These individuals will then work with leadership from our local SVdP district to ensure the conference is started up properly and that adequate volunteers have been recruited to serve those reaching out to our parish for assistance.

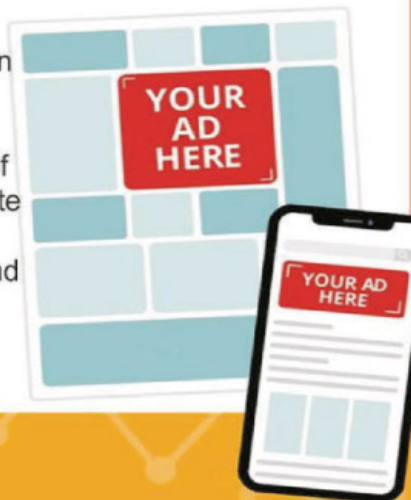

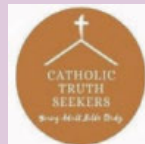

Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward.

"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire. And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life crippled than with two feet to be thrown into Gehenna. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. The hymn's verses are based on Ps. 19, the source of today's responsorial psalm. We hope you've enjoyed learning and singing this song of praise with us this month!



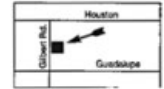
